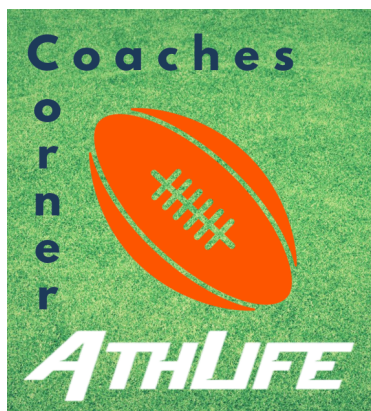


Professional Development Tips
