



## Trust Scholarship Application & Award Information

- You may apply for 2025 scholarship funding for future classes or education programs that begin **after** you receive a scholarship award notification from the Trust.
- Plan to apply for the scholarship **at least 4-6 weeks before** the start date of your classes or education program.
- The Trust will review scholarship applications and make awards on a **rolling basis**, with scholarship application reviews conducted every two weeks.
- Scholarship award decisions are typically made **within one month** of submitting your application.
- Schedule a call now with your AthLife Advisor to get started on the scholarship application process or with any questions.

## 3 Steps to Submit Your Tuition Bill

1. After you are awarded the scholarship, you are responsible for **submitting your tuition bill to the Trust for each term** of enrollment. Check your student portal for the tuition bill or contact your school's financial office.
2. Send your current tuition bill as a PDF attachment to [scholarship@playerstrust.com](mailto:scholarship@playerstrust.com) **as soon as it becomes available** and before the class is completed.
3. Please allow two weeks for the payment to process and reach your school. Contact the Trust at the email address listed above with any tuition payment questions.

- Confirm that you have all the resources you need for online learning, such as a working computer, webcam, access to the internet, and required software programs.
- Review your school's online learning platform, practice video chats, download materials, or other computer activities so that you are prepared for your online class.
- Review your syllabus, list assignments in your calendar or planner, and set reminders; be proactive and reach out to your professors with any questions.
- Try time blocking or another time management technique to balance your class assignments with your other responsibilities.
- Stay active in your course by taking part in online discussions and building connections with your professors and classmates, just like you would in a traditional classroom.

## The Importance of Note-Taking

Note-taking is an essential skill necessary to retain the information we learn, which is especially important in the classroom. Follow the strategies below to write more effective notes and increase your learning.

- Write phrases, not complete sentences, to capture the key points.
- Take notes in your own words to make it easier to remember.
- Use headings, subheadings, and numbered lists to help divide the information.
- Color code your notes to emphasize important information.
- Review and revise your notes soon after class to fill in missing details and reinforce what you learned.
